


Yes - OSCAR - There is a Santa Claus

*FIV stands for Feline Immunodeficiency Virus. It's a lentivirus, meaning it progresses very slowly, gradually affecting a cat's immune system. Normal tousling between cats does not transfer FIV. Only a deep penetrating bite wound can potentially transfer the disease. You cannot get FIV from a cat. Cats with this condition can live happy, normal life spans, and many live with non FIV-positive cats.

I am writing you because there are many kitties worldwide who need to believe in someone kind and generous like you. I am lucky that Cat Depot found me and made me their Mayor! Over the last year, I have learned there is something beyond my nine lives.


