### BRING CAT DEPOT TO YOUR CLASSROOM!

Students in grades K-5 can learn about various cat-related science topics through hands-on lessons. Multiple lessons are available for each grade level, with topics ranging from Nature of Science to Life Science. STEM lessons are also available. Each lesson can be modified to fit a 30-60-minute science block, and offer opportunities for kinesthetic, visual, and oral learners, as well as students receiving ELL and/or ESE supports. Lesson extensions are available for further learning and are taught by Cat Depot's Humane Educator, who has over 10 years experience teaching in Florida public schools. Lessons for grades 6+ are in the works!

Cat Depot can help start or expand an animal club at your school! Monthly visits can include a mini lesson covering topics such as animal shelters, cat breeds, proper cat care, and more. Students will also create items to be donated to local animal shelters and hold a donation drive / fundraiser.



Classes can come to Cat Depot's Community Center to either complete a science lesson or work on a service project for the adoptable cats in the shelter. Afterwards, students and staff can take a tour of the shelter.
